

# **Digestive System Hospital CPT Coding**

**OBJECTIVE:** This program will provide CPT and HCPCS Level II coding guidelines for hospital outpatient digestive system procedures that are commonly performed and/or difficult to code, including: Destruction, Gastrointestinal Endoscopy, Hernia Repair, Nasogastric Intubation, Gastrostomy Procedures, Hemorrhoidectomy, Abscess/Cyst Drainage Catheter, Tonsillectomy and Adenoidectomy, Bile Duct Stone Removal, Dental Procedures, Colorectal Cancer Screening Services. Exercises – based on actual ambulatory surgery operative reports - will allow staff responsible for hospital outpatient coding to understand the critical relationship between clinical data, official guidelines, accurate coding, and ambulatory payment classifications (APCs).

**AUDIENCE:** Coding Specialists, Coding Managers, Reimbursement Specialists, Compliance Auditors and Analysts, Hospital-Based Clinic Managers, and ALL hospital staff responsible for outpatient coding including emergency room, ancillary department and hospital-based clinic staff.
