

# **Female Genital System & Maternity Care and Delivery Hospital CPT Coding**

**OBJECTIVE:** This program will provide CPT and HCPCS Level II coding guidelines for hospital outpatient urinary procedures that are commonly performed and/or difficult to code, including: Lysis of Adhesions, Endometrial Ablation, Hysteroscopy with Dilation & Curettage, Laparoscopic/Endoscopic vs. Open Surgery, Bartholin's Gland Surgery, Cervical Biopsy, Vulva and Perineal Lesions, Pelvic Examinations, Vulvectomy, Vaginal Pessary, Burch Procedure, Cerclage Suture, Cervical/Vaginal Cancer Screening, Pap Smears, Cervix Uteri Excision, Treatment of Incomplete and Missed Abortions. Exercises – based on actual ambulatory surgery operative reports - will allow staff responsible for hospital outpatient coding to understand the critical relationship between clinical data, official guidelines, accurate coding, and ambulatory payment classifications (APCs).

**AUDIENCE:** Coding Specialists, Coding Managers, Reimbursement Specialists, Compliance Auditors and Analysts, Hospital-Based Clinic Managers, and ALL hospital staff responsible for outpatient coding including emergency room, ancillary department and hospital-based clinic staff.
