

Integumentary System Hospital CPT Coding

OBJECTIVE: This program will provide CPT and HCPCS Level II coding guidelines for hospital outpatient integumentary procedures that are commonly performed and/or difficult to code, including: Tissue Expander, Pedicle Flap, Pressure Ulcer, Skin Grafts, Nail Avulsion and Excision, Scar Revision, Burn Treatment, Lesion Excisions, Wound Repair, Adjacent Tissue Transfer/Rearrangement, Breast Surgery, Free Flaps with Microvascular Anastomosis, Dimensions for Wound Measurements. Exercises – based on actual ambulatory surgery operative reports - will allow staff responsible for hospital outpatient coding to understand the critical relationship between clinical data, official guidelines, accurate coding, and ambulatory payment classifications (APCs).

AUDIENCE: Coding Specialists, Coding Managers, Reimbursement Specialists, Compliance Auditors and Analysts, Hospital-Based Clinic Managers, and ALL hospital staff responsible for outpatient coding including emergency room, ancillary department and hospital-based clinic staff.

DURATION: 6 hours
