

Musculoskeletal System Hospital CPT Coding

OBJECTIVE: This program will provide CPT and HCPCS Level II coding guidelines for hospital outpatient musculoskeletal procedures that are commonly performed and/or difficult to code, including: Wound Exploration – Trauma, Ganglion Cyst, Arthroplasty, Arthroscopy, Biopsy, Bunionectomy , Graft, Joint Injections, Decompression Fasciotomy of Leg, Arthroscopic Knee Fracture Treatment, Treatment of Fractures/Dislocations, Skeletal Anatomy of Foot, Skeletal Anatomy of Hand, Surgical Knee Arthroscopy, Toe-to-Hand Transfer with Microvascular Anastomosis. Exercises – based on actual ambulatory surgery operative reports - will allow staff responsible for hospital outpatient coding to understand the critical relationship between clinical data, official guidelines, accurate coding, and ambulatory payment classifications (APCs).

AUDIENCE: Coding Specialists, Coding Managers, Reimbursement Specialists, Compliance Auditors and Analysts, Hospital-Based Clinic Managers, and ALL hospital staff responsible for outpatient coding including emergency room, ancillary department and hospital-based clinic staff.
