

The Coding Systems plus Coding Ambulatory Surgery

OBJECTIVE: This course will address the three hospital outpatient coding system: ICD-9-CM, CPT, and HCPCS Level II. The content will also include: official ICD-9-CM diagnostic coding guidelines for hospital-based outpatient settings; the structure and organization of the CPT code book; general guidelines and conventions of the CPT code book.
